

Our school year consists of 32 weeks of classes (four 8-week quarters). Classes are held on either Tuesdays or Thursdays (some math classes are *both* Tuesdays *and* Thursdays). See our school year calendar on our website at <http://www.gracehomeschoolconnection.org>.

TUITION RATES

1 HOUR CLASSES:	\$100/Quarter
1 ½ HOUR CLASSES:	\$150/Quarter
TWICE-WEEKLY MATH CLASSES:	\$200/Quarter
OMNIBUS CLASSES:	The Humanities classes will be charged at the rate of two 1½ hour classes, or \$300/quarter. Students will have 3 hours of in-class instruction and can earn 4 high school credit hours for course completion (History, English, Literature and Theology).

TUITION IS DUE ON THE FIRST DAY OF CLASSES. We offer quarterly or monthly payment plans. A quarter is 8 school weeks, approximately 2 months. Please see the annual calendar for payment due dates. Late Fees of \$10 will be applied to accounts not paid within 7 days of the posted due dates.

STUDY HALL: Each class of Study Hall has a \$10/Quarter fee. This fee is necessary to cover the costs of supervising each study hall. The half-hour gaps after our 1-hour classes will not incur a fee.

REGISTRATION FEES: Registration fees are \$75 per child or \$100 per family, Early registration (before May 31st) fees are \$37.50 per child or \$50.00 per family.

IGRADEPLUS FEES: Fees for our online grade communication system are \$8/student/year.

MATERIAL FEES: Some classes have a material fee charge for classroom supplies or materials. Please see course descriptions for these amounts.

FACILITIES FEES: A fee to cover the use of the facilities will be assessed for each student each academic year. It is \$145 per student, \$45 due at registration, \$25 per quarter for 4 quarters. This non-refundable fee will go directly to Church in the Gardens as reimbursement for facilities, administrative and custodial costs.

SECURITY FEES: A fee to cover the cost of police officer presence on campus when we meet. It is \$25 per quarter per student. The Police department cannot guarantee officer coverage for all dates.

TEXTBOOK & OTHER FEES: **Parents are responsible for purchasing textbooks for most classes.** A few classes order the necessary texts and workbooks for the class in advance (some Writing classes, for example). See Course Descriptions for required texts and fees.

PEP – OTHER SCHOLARSHIP FEE – There will be an administrative fee for providing the necessary invoices & receipts for submission to PEP or other government scholarship opportunities. This fee is \$15/student for the first quarter and \$10/student for each of the 2nd, 3rd and 4th quarters.

ALL MATERIAL FEES and IGRADE are due August 1st at the Mandatory Parent Meeting.

DROP FEES of \$50 per class apply to any course dropped during the year. Humanities classes have a higher drop fee of \$100 because they are equivalent to multiple courses. Please notify the teacher and Sandy Gray (gharryjr@bellsouth.net) IMMEDIATELY upon withdrawal from any course as a courtesy to the instructor and to avoid tuition charges from that date forward. Tuition charges will remain in effect until we have been properly notified of withdrawal.
